

SUBJECT: Proposed MILSTRIP Change Letter (PMCL) 2, Message Requisitions, Status, Followups, and Cancellations

1. References:

a. NAVSUP letter, 4400, 0322A3/0031, 10 November 1987, subject: Proposed MILSTRIP Change to Message Requisitions, Status, Followups, and Cancellations (NOTAL).

b. DoD 4000.25-1-M, 1 May 1987, Military Standard Requisitioning and Issue Procedures (MILSTRIP).

2. Proposed Change Concept/Rationale

a. Concept: This proposed change would eliminate the current restrictions on message requisitions to seven documents or one page, whichever is greater. Although this limitation has been in MILSTRIP since its inception, there is no known current logic for the restriction.

b. Rationale: When services are requisitioning from contractors under interim support agreements, they frequently have to send the requisitions by commercial means (Western Union) and the limitation of seven documents or one page greatly increases transmission costs and creates additional workload.

3. Interface/Impact Requirements:

a. Interface: Requires interface between MILSTRIP and Service/Agency requisition processing activities.

b. Impact: None known. Message requisitions are offline and, therefore, this change would have no systems impact.

4. Advantages/Disadvantages:

a. Advantages: Reduce time to set up and produce messages, reduce transmission costs, and reduce workload.

b. Disadvantages: None known.

Change Appendix A, as follows:

1. Delete paragraph 9.b.
2. Change existing 9.c to 9.b and add one sentence to read: "Narrative messages will only be used on an exception basis."
