MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: DoD Activity Address Directory (DoDAAD) and Air Force Expeditionary Combat Support System (ECSS) Meeting of Mar 31, 2010

Purpose: Defense Logistics Management Standards Office (DLMSO) hosted a meeting to gain a better understanding of the ECSS DoDAAD update replacement application and retirement of the existing Air Force DoDAAD update application.

Discussion. The meeting was facilitated by the Donald. Pipp, DLMSO Director. A list of participants is shown at Enclosure (1).

1. ECSS DoDAAD web update edits will equal the edits applied by Defense Automatic Addressing System Center (DAASC) web application.
2. DAASC will apply existing edits as part of the Web Service that move AF data from ECSS to DAASC.
3. ECSS will ensure that all enterprise-wide data fields within the DAASC database and edits in the DAASC web update application are accommodated by the ECSS application.
4. ECSS will roll out the workflow in Pilot C (April 2011), so AF individuals will be able to request a DoDAAC when needed. Workflow requirement has been approved. ECSS now is the process of documenting workflow requirements.
5. ECSS will totally subsume the existing AF Legacy system, with the exception of the existing AF DODAAD Web query.
6. ECSS will be the AF DoDAAD information HUB; however DoDAAD query functionality to AF customers will be via eDAASINQ.
7. AF Legacy will run in parallel until ECSS is fully deployed. As ECSS bases come online, the Legacy AF DoDAAC update responsibility will shift from Legacy to ECSS.
