3. REQUESTED CHANGE:

a. Title: ADC 173, Administrative Correction to DLMS Supplement 846A, Asset Reclassification (Supply)

b. Description of Change: This update deletes code “ABR – Assigned by Receiver in the LQ segment of DLMS Supplement (DS) 846A; and provides an administrative update to delete a DLMS note in the LIN segment.

c. Procedures: Revise DS 846A as follows:

This is an Air Force-unique data element, meaningful to the Air Force only. Non-Air Force Components perpetuate without action.
