

3. Although Navy provided a preferred implementation date of 1 Nov 87, the DoD MILSTRIP System Administrator does not believe that changes beneficial to other Services/Agencies should be put off to accommodate a single Service/Agency. If Navy is unable to meet the 1 Nov 85 date, the change will be implemented with instructions for customers not to use the new codes in requisitions submitted to Navy activities (until 1 Nov 87). Requisitions submitted from Navy customers to other Services/Agencies without the new codes would not pose a problem to any party.

Approved MILSTRIP Change Letter (AMCL) 122
Media and Status Codes To Indicate Status to Both Requisitioner
and Supplementary Address

1. Change paragraph 7-6a to read:

"a. To the activity designated by the M&S code unless covered by the exceptions listed below."

2. Add a new paragraph 7-6d to read:

"d. When the M&S code is F, G, P, or Z, transmit requests to the requisitioner (cc 30-35)."

3. Revise appendix B4, paragraph b(1)(a) [referencing AMCL 107] as follows:

"(a) The M&S code may indicate that status is to be furnished to the requisitioner (cc 30-35) and/or the supplementary addressee (cc 45-50)."

4. Add the following new M&S codes to appendix B4:

<u>Code</u>	<u>Explanation</u>
Z	Exception supply status and shipment status to requisitioner and supplementary address by data pattern (AUTODIN).
F	100% supply status and shipment status to requisitioner and supplementary address by data pattern (AUTODIN).
P	Exception supply status and shipment status to requisitioner and supplementary address on a Clear-Text Supply Status/Shipment Information Mailer prepared by DAAS.
G	100% supply status and shipment status to requisitioner and supplementary address on a Clear-Text Supply Status/Shipment Information Mailer prepared by DAAS.
